Our Camps

Our programs develop student's knowledge, understanding and skills to strengthen their sense of self, and build interpersonal relationships.

Using content with links to the Health and Physical Education (and many other Curriculum Areas) program activities focus on personal and social skills that can be developed through their participation in the journey based program. MT LOFTY RANGES Suits: Year 7-8

An easy to intermediate 2 or 3 day walk with a rural feel as students pass through parks and bushland.

With 2 different routes available this journey can cater for 60 students.

KUITPO FOREST Suits: Year 7-9

An easy to intermediate 2 or 3 day walk along the Heysen Trail. The trail winds through both pine plantation forests and native woodland.

With 2 different routes available this journey can cater for 60 students.

MT CRAWFORD

Suits: Year 9-11

An intermediate 3 day walk that follows the forest edges and roadsides. The trail then makes its way up and over the pretty Wirra Wirra Peaks, before descending to creek lines again.

With 4 different routes this journey can cater for over 60 students.

DEEP CREEK CONSERVATION PARK

Suits: Year 10-12

A challenging 3 or 4 day walk on SA's premier long distance walking trail. This section is characterized by rugged coastal scenery and dense native scrub.
